

Christians, but also to certain categories of the immoveables of foreigners. TYSER, C.J. The devolution of these on death is governed by the law of the Ottoman State, and according to that law, a Frenchman cannot inherit from a German, or a Greek from an Ottoman subject, and *vice versa*. Possibly the section was inserted to make it quite clear that this principle was not part of the Law of Cyprus under the new Statute.

I agree that the appeal must be allowed with costs.
