CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS FROM TAXATION.

G. J. WOLSELEY.]

[May 3, 1879.

1. There shall not be claimed by or allowed to any person, native or alien, whose domicile for the time being is this Island, and whether under plea or pretence of custom, licence, nationality, condition, creed, calling or otherwise, the right of exemption from payment of any of the several taxes, duties, imposts or obligations enumerated in the Schedule to this Law.

No one exempt from taxes enumerated in schedule.

No one exempt from future taxation, save as may for the future be provided for.

2. No right of exemption from payment of any tax, impost, duty or obligation to be hereafter established in this Island by Law or other competent authority shall be claimed by or allowed to any person except where such exemption is by the Law or authority establishing such tax, impost, duty or obligation expressly stated and allowed.
