1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property Registration and Valuation Law, 1924, and shall be read as one with the Immovable Property Registration and Valuation Law, 1907, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), the Immovable Property Registration and Valuation Law, 1909, the Immovable Property Registration and Valuation Law, 1913, and the Immovable Property Registration and Valuation Law, 1922, and the Principal Law and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Immovable Property Registration and Valuation Laws, 1907 to 1924.

Short title.

2. The Principal Law, section 13 (1), is hereby amended by the insertion therein after the words "immovable property" of the words "whether the ownership is by any law or custom required or not required to be registered in the books of the Land Registry Office."

3. Any act or thing done or omitted under the provisions of the Principal Law or any law amending the same which would have been validly and properly done or omitted under the Principal Law or any law amending the same if section 13 (1) of the Principal Law had been as provided by this Law shall be deemed to be and to have been validly and properly done thereunder.
