A.D. 1926. TO MAKE TEMPORARY PROVISION IN RESPECT OF THE
7 of 1926. LAND REGISTRY OFFICE AT KYRENIA.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the records of the Land Registry Office at Kyrenia have been destroyed by fire.

And whereas it is expedient to take temporary measures so as to provide for their reconstruction.

BE it therefore enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Land Registry Office (Kyrenia) Law, 1926.

Period from 4th Feb., 1926, to 1st May, 1926 not to count as part of prescribed period to which formal act in Land Registry Office, Kyrenia, has to be done.

2. When any act is required to be done under any Law, Regulation, Rule of Court, Order of the Court, or Land Registry Office notice in connection with or relating to registration or transfer of property or any other formal act in the Land Registry Office at Kyrenia within a prescribed period, the period from the 4th day of February, 1926, to the 1st day of May, 1926, inclusive shall not count as part of such prescribed period.

Power to Governor to make Regulations.

3. The Governor may, by Order, make regulations and when made alter, vary and amend the same to deal with the emergency caused by the destruction of the Land Registry Office records in the preamble to this Law mentioned.

Penalty for breach of Regulation

4. Any person who commits a breach of any Regulation made under the provisions of this Law shall, on conviction thereof, be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds.

This Law was published in the Cyprus Gazette No. 1754 of the 19th February, 1926.
