BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment (No. 5) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, as amended by the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment Law, 1932, the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment (No. 2) Law, 1932, the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment (No. 3) Law, 1932, and the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Amendment (No. 4) Law, 1932, (hereinafter together referred to as "the Order").

2. The Fourth Schedule to the Order is hereby amended by the insertion in their appropriate alphabetical places therein of the following goods among the goods charged with the payment of two-thirds of the full rate of duty:—

Butter.
Cheese.
Timber.
Tinned fish.
