BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property (Amendment) Law, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property Laws, 1930 to 1935, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Recovery of Compensation for Injury to Property Laws, 1930 to 1937.

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—

Repeal of the Second Schedule to the Principal Law and substitution of new Schedule.

"SECOND SCHEDULE.

FEEES.

Where the total amount of compensation costs and fees as contained in the list mentioned in section 7 :—

- (a) does not exceed five pounds .. .. a sum of 1*p.*
- (b) exceeds five pounds but does not exceed fifteen pounds .. .. a sum of 2*p.*
- (c) exceeds fifteen pounds but does not exceed forty pounds .. .. a sum of 4*p.*
- (d) exceeds forty pounds .. .. a sum of 6*p.*"

A LAW TO AMEND THE BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION LAWS, 1895 AND 1928.

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Law, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Births and Deaths Registration Laws, 1895 and 1928, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Laws, 1895 to 1937.

2. Section 21 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "the sum of 3*c.p.* in respect of each entry of a birth and 4½*c.p.* in respect of each entry of a death" and by the substitution therefor of the words "the sum of four and a half piastres in respect of each entry of a birth or of a death".
