Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939.
