*Governor.*

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939.

## A LAW TO AMEND THE TOBACCO LAWS, 1932 TO 1936.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Law, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1939.

2. Section 38 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

"Consumption duty.

38. There shall be paid in the manner hereinafter provided upon every oke of manufactured tobacco consumption duty at the rate of twelve shillings and four piastres."
