**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and  
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as  
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) (Continuance) Law, 1939. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in section 10 of the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to (No. 2) 1939, or in any other Law contained, the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to (No. 2) 1939, shall continue in force until the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 1940. Continuance of the Immovable Property (Restriction and Postponement of Sales) Laws, 1935 to (No. 2) 1939.
