A LAW TO AMEND THE CYPRUS PENSIONS ORDERS
AND LAWS, 1929 TO 1938.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus Pensions Order Short title.

of the Order.

2. Section 2 of the Order, as amended by section 2 (a) of the Cyprus Pensions Order in Council, 1929, (Amendment) Law, 1938, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition of "pensionable emoluments", and by the substitution therefor of the following definition:—

"The term 'pensionable emoluments'—

(a) in respect of service in Cyprus includes—

- (i) salary,
- (ii) personal allowance,
- (iii) house allowance,

but does not include duty pay or allowance, entertainment allowance or any other emoluments whatever:

Provided that in the case of a constable and in the case of a Sergeant-Major Warder, Sergeant Warder or Warder in the Prison Service it shall also include good conduct pay and merit allowance but shall not include house allowance;

(b) in respect of other public service means emoluments which count for pension in accordance with the Law or Regulations in force in such service."
