THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

A LAW TO AMEND THE VEHICLES LIGHTS LAW, 1909.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Vehicles Lights Short title.
(Amendment) Law, 1941, and shall be read as one with 9 of 1909
the Vehicles Lights Law, 1909, (hereinafter referred to as
“the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law
may together be cited as the Vehicles Lights Laws, 1909
and 1941.

2. Section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by Amendment

the deletion therefrom of the words “one hour after sunset
and one hour before sunrise” and the substitution therefor
of the words “half an hour after sunset and half an hour
before sunrise”.
