A LAW TO AMEND THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR (MANUFACTURE) LICENSING LAW, 1941.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor Short title. (Manufacture) Licensing (Amendment) Law, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Licensing Law, 1941, (hereinafter referred 2 of 1941 to as “the principal Law”), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Manufacture) Licensing Laws, 1941.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 5 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the deletion therefrom of the words “two shillings” and the substitution therefor of the words “four shillings”;
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the Proviso and the substitution therefor of the following Proviso:—
“Provided that any intoxicating liquor which the Comptroller is satisfied was issued—
(a) for use as fuel;
(b) to the Director of Medical Services for medicinal and surgical use by the Medical and Health Services of the Colony;
(c) to His Majesty’s Forces for medicinal and surgical use;
shall not be taken into account in such assessment.”
