THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 11 OF 1942.

A LAW TO AMEND THE GAMBLING LAW, 1896.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Gambling (Amendment) Law, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Gambling Law, 1896, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Gambling Laws, 1896 and 1942. Short title.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 1 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following sub-section substituted therefor :—

“ Persons
playing
cholo and
kazandi
guilty of
an offence.

(2) Any person found playing at the games called ‘cholo’ and ‘kazandi’ or being in possession of appliances for the games called ‘cholo’ and ‘kazandi’ shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two pounds and any such appliances may be forfeited.”
