A LAW TO AMEND THE PARTNERSHIP LAWS, 1928 AND 1941.

*Officer Administering the Government.*

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Partnership (Amendment) Law, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Partnership Laws, 1928 and 1941 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Partnership Laws, 1928 to 1949.

Amendment of section 51 of the principal Law.

2. Section 51 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the insertion therein, immediately after paragraph (g), of the following paragraph :—

“(h) the names of the partners who are authorized to administer the affairs of the partnership, to manage it and to sign for it,”;

(b) by the insertion therein, immediately after the words “a statement” of the words “in the prescribed form”.

Insertion of new section 51A in the principal Law.

3. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after section 51, of the following section :—

“Registration of dissolution in certain cases.

51A. If, during the continuance of a partnership, a dissolution other than a dissolution as provided by paragraph (a) or (b) of sub-section (1) of section 33 takes place, a statement in the prescribed form signed by the firm shall, within seven days from the date of the dissolution, be sent by post or delivered to the Registrar.”

Amendment of section 52 of the principal Law.

4. Section 52 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion in the marginal note of the words “as to registration”;

(b) by the insertion in sub-section (1) thereof, immediately after the word “registration” (line 2) of the words “, changes or dissolution”.

Amendment of section 53 of the principal Law.

5. Section 53 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of the word “a” (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the word “any”;

(b) by the deletion therefrom of the words “of particulars or of any change in particulars” (line 2) and of the words “or change in the particulars” (line 9).

Deletion of section 54 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

6. Section 54 of the principal Law is hereby deleted and the following section substituted therefor :—

“Notices in the Gazette.

54. Any statement registered by the Registrar under the provisions of this Law shall be published in the *Cyprus Gazette*.”
