CAP. 37 A LAW TO AMEND THE AGRICULTURAL FERTILIZERS LAW.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Agricultural Fertilizers (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Fertilizers Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. The proviso to section 3 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

"Provided that the Director of Agriculture may, in his discretion, by writing under his hand and subject to such conditions as he may prescribe, permit the sale of any fertilizer, whether by wholesale or retail, notwithstanding that the fertilizer is not contained in sacks and is not sealed as aforesaid".
