**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

**A LAW TO AMEND THE GUARDIANSHIP OF INFANTS AND CAP. 102.**  
**PRODIGALS LAW.**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and  
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as  
follows :—

**1.** This Law may be cited as the Guardianship of Infants and Prodigals (Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Guardianship of Infants and Prodigals Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. The long title of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "not being Heirs under Disability" (lines 1 and 2).

3. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of "infant" therein of the following definition:—

" 'infant' means a person who has not attained the age of eighteen years :

Provided that a married woman who has not attained the age of eighteen years shall not be deemed to be an infant for the purposes of this Law."

4. The principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after section 7, of the following new section:—

" Registrar  
to be  
guardian in  
certain cases.

7A. Where the Court is of opinion that there is no person suitable and willing to be appointed guardian of the property of an infant, the Court shall declare such infant to be a ward of Court and the Registrar shall have in respect of the property of the infant, the powers of a guardian and shall perform his duties as guardian in such manner as the Court may, subject to any Rules of Court, direct."
