Preamble.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1958, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commanderin-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1958.

2.
