## CHAPTER 111.

## PASSPORTS (FALSE REPRESENTATIONS).

TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL LAWS.

[ 1st May, 1920.] <sup>1949 Cap. 26</sup>.

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Passports (False Representations) Law.
- 2. If any person shall for the purpose of obtaining a passport make any false representation or any statement to false in a material particular he shall be liable in respect statement in regard to passports. or to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds or to both 2 of 2/55. such imprisonment and fine.
