Short title. **1.** This Law may be cited as the Village Authorities
(Fees Regulation) Law.

Fees to be
increased,
decreased or
cancelled by
Order-in-
Council. **2.** Whenever any fee is payable to, or is levied or received
by, any mukhtar or aza under any Law in force for the time
being, such fee may be increased, decreased or cancelled by
an Order of the Governor in Council to be published in the
Gazette.

Fees in the
Order-in-
Council to
be payable,
etc., to
mukhtars
and azas. **3.** During the continuance in force of an Order in Council
made under the provisions of section 2 of this Law, the fees
set out therein shall be payable to, and shall be levied or
received by, mukhtars and azas in lieu of the fees set out in
the Law affected by such Order.
